LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

January 18, 2022

Dear Colleagues,

As President of the NAEO, it is my pleasure to invite you to the National Association of Extradition Officials' 57th Annual Training Conference in Austin, Texas. The Conference is an incredible opportunity for you to expand your knowledge on the Interstate Agreement on Detainers and the extradition process at the local, state, and federal levels. We strive to provide information that will assist you in navigating these unique areas of law.

The conference will be held Sunday, June 5 to Tuesday, June 7, 2021, at the high tech AT&T Hotel and Conference Center on the University of Austin, Texas campus in downtown Austin. The hotel is a short walk from many live venues in the Live Music Capital of the World. Austin is also home to the Austin Football Club (Austin FC), an American professional soccer club, which began play in the 2021 season. Austin is known as the "Bat City" with their moto, "Keep Austin Weird."

As to the training, for the second year, due to the unknown status of agency and personal travel restrictions, our conference will be hybrid, meaning the conference will be open to both in-person attendance in Austin and the opportunity to attend virtually.

The goals of our conference are simple – to provide a training opportunity to address these specialized areas, and to provide an opportunity for persons in this small field contacts and networking opportunities with others in this field.

As always, the conference will focus on fundamentals of interstate extradition and the Interstate Agreement on Detainers. There will also be presentations on bail, law enforcement and extraditions, juvenile extraditions, international extraditions, and extraditions from a judge's perspective. We learned a great deal from our first hybrid experience in 2021 and aim to bring you a conference that is technologically advanced and incorporates new training techniques so both the newest attendee and the most veteran will obtain some new knowledge and highlights this year. The tentative agenda and registration information is contained in this brochure and may also be found at the NAEO website at www.extraditionofficials.org. On the website you can both register and pay for your conference attendance.

For in-person attendees, we will request compliance with current state regulations for social distancing and masks. I encourage in-person attendees to bring their laptops or tablets so that you can access the course material and participate in online surveys. For virtual attendees, we have partnered with a company to provide secure login capability so you can stream the conference, whether in the office or at home. Our daily agendas accommodate all time zones. Everyone, both in-person (with your technology) and virtually, will have the ability to send messages to other attendees and submit questions to the presenters. And all attendees will have access to recordings of most of the live presentations for a week after the conference.

As for networking, one of the best aspects of the Annual Training Conference is the participation of attendees from all over the United States and its territories. The conference provides a tremendous opportunity not only to learn about extradition, but to share ideas and experiences with other attendees. Additionally, it provides a unique opportunity to make valuable contacts with other extradition officials in different jurisdictions that can be subsequently utilized to resolve problems or issues that may arise in the future. These networking opportunities are greatest in-person, but we worked with our vendor to provide chat options for virtual attendees.

The biggest question is cost. The registration fee for both in-person and virtual attendance is the same. As noted, we have partnered with a professional audio-visual company to provide interactive, professional, and easy access for both presenters and attendees, from designing the conference website, to ensure superior show quality, to easy access to presentations and materials, to the ability to complete online surveys, to equal opportunity to submit questions anonymously through the conference website, to allowing later access to presentations. Unfortunately, the cost to bring you such superior and specialized services is high but necessary to ensure every attendee can receive the best experience.

The conference registration fee includes a flash drive containing the PowerPoints and materials discussed by the presenters. In-person attendees will receive their flash drive upon checking for the conference; we will mail the flash drives to virtual attendees. There are in-person only events, including an opening reception on June 5; a hosted dinner on June 6; and our annual luncheon on June 7.
